INDUSTRY RECALL: SunSprout Enterprises Voluntarily Recalls Two Lots of Alfalfa Sprouts Due to Potential Contamination with Salmonella

Midwest Foods IS NOT Involved in This Alert

December 29th, 2022

SunSprout enterprises is recalling two lots of its raw alfalfa sprouts, with best by dates between 12/10/22 and 12/27/22 due to potential contamination with Salmonella. The recalled raw alfalfa sprouts were in 4 ounce clamshell packages and were distributed in Nebraska, Kansas, and Iowa between late November and early December 2022. They can be identified by the lot codes #4211 and 5211. At this time no illnesses have been reported in connection with this issue.

If you have any affected product, please do not consume it. Discard the product as directed by the FDA and contact SunSprout to obtain a refund. They can be reached at 402.331.0803.
