INDUSTRY RECALL: Sofia Produce, LLC DBA Trufresh Recalls Fresh Cantaloupe Because of Possible Health Risk Due to Salmonella

Midwest Foods is NOT Affected

Update: November 21st, 2023

Sofia Produce recently added sales order numbers to the list of those that were affected by this recall. Midwest Foods product is still not affected. You can view the recall [here](#).

Alert from November 10th, 2023:

Sofia Produce, LLC, doing business as “Truefresh” is recalling cantaloupe sold between October 16, 2023 and October 23, 2023 due to possible Salmonella contamination. The affected product came in cardboard containers, in various sizes, with the “Malichita” label. The product was distributed in Arizona, California, Maryland, New Jersey, Tennessee, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Texas, Florida and Canada. Customers can identify the product by looking for the “Malichita” label on the packaging, as well as an individual PLU sticker (shown below) on each cantaloupe with the word “Malichita” on top and the number “4050” on the bottom, along with the words “Product of Mexico/ produit du Mexique”. There have been no illnesses reported in association with this recall, as of now. Do not consume or sell any recalled product. Return or dispose of the product.
