We're excited to feature a true farm-to-table standout this week: freshly harvested red and golden beets, grown right here in Chicago by Windy City Harvest. This local urban farm program trains future growers in sustainable agriculture practices while providing high-quality produce to the city's culinary community. Their beets are earthy, vibrant, and packed with nutrients—delivered in beautiful bunches that are as versatile as they are eye-catching.

The deep red variety brings a rich, bold flavor and natural sweetness that intensifies when roasted, while golden beets offer a slightly milder taste and striking color that holds up well in both raw and cooked applications. Shave them thin into summer salads, roast and toss with citrus, or feature them pickled alongside grilled meats or on charcuterie boards. Their natural sugars also make them ideal for purées, beet hummus, or even infused syrups and vinaigrettes.

Arizona A strong high brings nearrecord highs Wed–Thurs: 112–117°F in AZ, 115–121°F in southeast CA. Morning lows rise from low 80s to upper 80s. Slight cooling into the weekend, but temps stay above normal.

California Temps will rise this week with above-average warmth. Coastal highs will be in the low 60s to 70s, while inland areas reach the 80s to low 100s, especially south of Soledad. Temps peak Thursday, then cool slightly—by up to 5 degrees— into the weekend.

Florida Warm, humid conditions continue across Florida through the weekend, with scattered showers and storms. Rainfall will range from 0.05"–0.30", locally higher. Highs stay in the upper 80s to mid-90s, with gusts under 20 mph through Friday. **Mexico** Scattered showers and storms are expected through July 13th, with 0.10"–0.35" of rain, possibly more in storms. Conditions stay humid with near to slightly below normal temps. Highs will be in the low 70s to low 80s, and lows in the mid 50s to mid 60s.
