Recent heavy rainfall across all current growing regions—including California, Yuma, Oxnard, and Salinas—creating industry-wide supply challenges. Growers are reporting delayed harvests, lighter weights, and inconsistent quality across several commodities, with the most significant impact on leafy items, baby salads, Brussels sprouts, and celery. Strawberry supplies are also expected to be extremely limited following this week's storms.

Arizona Wetter week ahead with showers midweek through Saturday; dry Sunday. Highs low-mid 60s Friday, warming mid-60s-mid-70s Sunday; lows mid-upper 40s, rising to ~50.

California Clouds increase Wednesday with a low-pressure system. Light showers overnight through early Friday (¼"-¾"), then clearing with highs upper 50s-low 70s and inland lows mid-30s over the weekend.

Florida Warm and mostly dry through Sunday, highs upper 70smid-80s, lows 50s–60s, winds 1520 mph. **Mexico** Warm and mostly dry, highs mid-70s-mid-80s, lows upper 40supper 50s.
